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## EXECUTIVE **SUMMARY**

Between 2022 and 2024, Alliance Consultancy, in close collaboration with Alliance for Public Health (APH) and a network of global and regional partners, successfully implemented 11 projects, with 2 ongoing into 2025. These initiatives focused on strengthening healthcare systems, responding to crises, expanding telemedicine solutions, providing technical assistance, and driving policy advocacy. Throughout this period, the organization played a crucial role in ensuring continuous healthcare access for vulnerable populations, including key populations (KPs), people living with HIV (PLHIV), internally displaced people (IDPs), and refugees, across more than 50 countries and 220 cities.

The war in Ukraine created unprecedented challenges for healthcare access, requiring urgent intervention to support displaced individuals and communities affected by disruptions in medical services. In response, Alliance Consultancy, through the HelpNow HUB, provided over 35,000 essential health services, including support for antiretroviral therapy (ART) continuation, opioid agonist therapy (OAT), mental health support, and emergency medical navigation. This initiative became a vital healthcare coordination mechanism, ensuring that displaced Ukrainians in over 50 countries could access treatment and support.

Telemedicine and digital healthcare solutions became a cornerstone of healthcare continuity during this period. Through Help24 TeleHealth and the HelpNow Clinical HUB, Alliance Consultancy facilitated more than 20,000 online medical consultations, addressing healthcare gaps for displaced populations and those unable to access in-person medical services. The establishment of three telemedicine hubs in Kyiv, Dnipro, and Khmelnytskyi further expanded access to digital healthcare, integrating hybrid models that combined virtual consultations with in-person medical care. These efforts also contributed to the development of national policies on telemedicine, in close collaboration with the Public Health Center of Ukraine and other stakeholders, ensuring the longterm sustainability of digital health services.









Beyond direct healthcare delivery, Alliance Consultancy played a leading role in policy engagement and community-led monitoring (CLM). As a technical assistance (TA) provider in partnership with Eastern Africa National Networks of AIDS and Health Service Organizations (EANNASO), and Asia/ Pacific Council of AIDS Service Organizations organization (APCASO), the developed specialized CLM tools and provided guidance on data collection, advocacy, and service accountability. Community-led monitoring frameworks were expanded across multiple countries, with direct technical support provided to organizations in Moldova, the Philippines, and Bangladesh, enhancing civil society engagement in healthcare governance.

Technical assistance was another key area of impact, with support provided to national healthcare systems in Serbia, Ukraine, and Kyrgyzstan. These interventions strengthened national HIV and TB programs, improved civil society participation in healthcare policy, and supported harm reduction initiatives for people who use drugs (PWUD). Additionally, research and evidence-based interventions conducted

in collaboration with **EMCDDA** and **KPMG Bulgaria** contributed to national and regional drug policy reforms, generating data to inform more effective public health strategies.

Looking ahead, Alliance Consultancy will continue expanding its healthcare initiatives, with a strong focus on scaling up Help24 TeleHealth into new regions, integrating telemedicine into Ukraine's national healthcare framework, and enhancing community-led monitoring models to improve healthcare service accountability. Additionally, the organization will strengthen regional partnerships to improve cross-border healthcare access and support for displaced populations.

Between 2022 and 2024, Alliance Consultancy demonstrated resilience, innovation, and leadership in public health, ensuring healthcare continuity despite crisis conditions. As the organization moves into 2025 and beyond, it remains committed to expanding digital healthcare solutions, strengthening healthcare systems, and fostering global health collaborations to ensure accessible, barrier-free, high-quality medical care for all, regardless of circumstances.

## **GENERAL PROGRAM OVERVIEW:** 202<del>2</del> 2024

Over the past three years, Alliance Consultancy has played an important role in strengthening healthcare systems, supporting communities and urgent responses and ensuring uninterrupted medical care amid a rapidly evolving global landscape. Our work has been shaped by the urgency of crisis response, digital transformation in healthcare, regional capacity-building, and policy-driven advocacy, all of which have contributed to a sustainable and impactful public health ecosystem.

## Crisis-Driven Innovation and Emergency Response

The full-scale war in Ukraine dramatically reshaped healthcare delivery, necessitating urgent, innovative solutions to ensure that key populations (KPs) and people living with HIV (PLHIV) continued to receive essential services. In response, together with Alliance for Public Health and support of number of CSO's we launched HelpNow HUB, a comprehensive emergency intervention that connected displaced individuals with life-saving healthcare services, HIV prevention and ART continuity, Hepatitis tuberculosis-related treatments, OAT, mental health support, and humanitarian aid across multiple countries. Despite overwhelming teams ensured real-time challenges, our navigation, coordination, and direct service provision, extending our reach to refugees and internally displaced people (IDPs) across more than 200 cities in over 50 countries.



Recognizing the fragmentation of healthcare access due to war and forced migration, we also integrated telemedicine solutions into emergency response programs, allowing displaced communities to consult with doctors remotely. The HelpNow Clinical HUB, a multidisciplinary team of healthcare professionals, was developed to provide virtual consultations, bringing together infectious disease specialists, mental health professionals, and primary care providers to address the diverse medical needs of war-affected populations.

## **Expansion of Telemedicine**

## and Digital Health Solutions

The post-pandemic era and wartime instability underscored the critical importance telemedicine in ensuring continuity of care. In response, in 2023 together with APH we have re-launched the existing Help24 portal into a comprehensive Help24 TeleHealth Platform. Moreover, the Help24 TeleHealth Online Clinic (h24.org.ua) was established as a comprehensive clinic offering remote consultations, ART and PrEP prescriptions, psychological support, and STI management, free laboratory testsand refferals for vulnerable populations in Ukraine. This platform, initially conceived as a wartime emergency response tool, quickly evolved into a scalable telemedicine infrastructure, supporting thousands of patients both within Ukraine and abroad.

To strengthen the integration of telehealth into national healthcare systems, Alliance Consultancy worked closely with health authorities to standardize telemedicine protocols, facilitate digital patient records, and ensure the seamless integration of online medical services into Ukraine's national electronic health system. Additionally, three telemedicine hubs were established in Kyiv, Dnipro, and Khmelnytskyi

that provide no only in-person, but virtual consultations through Online clinic, allowing for hybrid care models that accommodate both digital and offline healthcare access.



## **Policy Impact** and Community-Led Monitoring (CLM) -

In addition to healthcare service provision and capacity-building, Alliance Consultancy has been at the forefront of advocacy and policy transformation. As a leader in Community-Led Monitoring (CLM), we have worked alongside national and international stakeholders to drive data-driven improvements in healthcare service delivery.

Through structured community engagement, research, and advocacy, we have provided key insights into gaps in healthcare accessibility, influencing health strategies at both national and regional levels. Our partnerships with the Public Health Center of Ukraine, Ministries of Health, and international organizations have helped to advance progressive health policies, funding mechanisms, and regulatory reforms that directly impact PLHIV, key populations, and marginalized groups.



## 1. ONLINE DOCTOR CONSULTATIONS & HELPNOW CLINICAL HUB (2023–2024)

### Overview

The Online Doctor Consultations and HelpNow Clinical HUB initiative was developed to ensure continuity of healthcare services for people living with HIV (PLHIV) and key populations (KPs) in Ukraine and among displaced communities abroad. This initiative integrated telemedicine solutions to provide remote consultations, medical support, and multidisciplinary care through **Help24**, addressing the unique challenges created by the ongoing war and healthcare disruptions.

## Key Objectives:



Provide accessible, highquality telemedicine services for PLHIV and KPs, mitigating barriers to inperson healthcare.



Strengthen multidisciplinary healthcare support through a centralized Clinical Hub, offering expertise in HIV treatment, mental health, and co-infections.



Enhance the Help24 telemedicine platform to include expanded medical services such as HIV PrEP, opioid agonist therapy (OAT), and tuberculosis (TB) co-infection management.

## Implementation & Achievements:

**23,142 online medical consultations** delivered *11,364 consultations in 2023* across Ukraine and internationally:

**11,778** consultations in 2024

5,538 Ukrainians living with HIV received medical consultations:

**2,861** individuals in 2023 **2.677** individuals in 2024

- Multidisciplinary medical team of 38 doctors established, comprising infectious disease specialists, mental health professionals, and HIV clinicians from 23 out of 25 regions of Ukraine.
- **87 weekly Clinical Hub meetings conducted,** providing a structured platform for peer learning, medical case discussions, and professional knowledge exchange:

**45** sessions in 2023 **42** sessions in 2024

553 patient medical data forms were prepared and coordinated upon request to facilitate medical assistance: 322 patients in 2024

**231** patients in 2023

- Strengthened the integration of digital medical services into Ukraine's health system by collaborating with the Public Health Center of Ukraine and leading healthcare organizations.
- Ensured ART (antiretroviral therapy) continuity, mental health support, and harm reduction services for internally displaced people (IDPs) and refugees, preventing treatment interruptions and improving long-term health outcomes.

## **Impact** & Strategic Significance:

The Online Doctor Consultations & HelpNow Clinical HUB project has demonstrated the effectiveness of telemedicine in crisis settings, ensuring healthcare access for vulnerable populations during wartime disruptions. By combining digital consultations with a multidisciplinary medical approach, initiative has created a scalable model for future telehealth expansion.

Beyond service delivery, this initiative has contributed to strengthening the national healthcare infrastructure, supporting policy development for telemedicine integration in Ukraine. Additionally, it has played a crucial role in building medical expertise, providing ongoing education and support for healthcare providers, and ensuring that displaced individuals continue to receive high-quality, stigma-free medical care.

## **2. HELPNOW HUB:** EMERGENCY SUPPORT TO UKRAINIAN REFUGEES (2022–2023)





#### Implementation:

#### Overview |

The **HelpNow HUB** was established as an emergency response mechanism to address the urgent healthcare and humanitarian needs of Ukrainian refugees and internally displaced people (IDPs). Launched in response to the full-scale invasion to Ukraine, the initiative provided a critical lifeline for people living with HIV (PLHIV), key populations (KPs), and individuals requiring opioid agonist therapy (OAT) who faced barriers to accessing treatment due to displacement.

HelpNow Service was launched by Alliance for Public Health within first days of large scale war in 2022 and continued and expanded by Alliance Consultancy since March 2022. The service developed into comprehensive HelpNowHUB with different services and Hubs. HelpNow HUB served as a centralized coordination and navigation service, ensuring displaced individuals could connect with healthcare providers, access medications, and receive psychosocial support. Over the course of its operation, the initiative evolved into a cross-border support network, extending its reach across **over 50 countries and 200+ cities.**

Supported registration of HelpNow Poland, ensuring sustainable regional support, supported the BaltHUB transformation and operations:



HELP HelpNow Poland transitioned into a registered community-led **POLAND** organization, continuing to provide assistance to refugees.



BaltHUB, coordinated by Estonian partners, became a regional actor supporting Ukrainian refugees in Nordic and Baltic states.



Provided 15,332 online medical consultations via the HelpNow Clinical HUB for refugees in 2022-2023, assisting refugees in accessing specialized HIV care. 31 weekly Clinical Hub meetings conducted in 2022, supporting the medical case discussions and professional knowledge exchange.



Integrated telemedicine referrals through Help24, allowing displaced individuals to receive remote consultations and medical coordination.



Engaged community-based peer navigators in Poland, Germany, and Moldova, other countries, to ensure culturally competent and locally adapted support.



Developed and maintained an interactive online platform, providing healthcare roadmaps, legal information, and patient testimonials to aid refugees in navigating host country health systems.



### **Impact** & Strategic Significance:

The **HelpNow HUB** was one of the largest coordinated emergency healthcare responses for displaced Ukrainians in the HIV sector. The initiative not only provided information and direct medical and social support but also created and supported long-term community-led solutions, ensuring sustainability beyond the initial project

period. By transitioning services to community-based organizations in Poland and the Baltic region, HelpNow HUB has set a precedent for sustainable humanitarian response models that bridge healthcare gaps for displaced populations.





## **3. HELP24 TELEHEALTH** – ONLINE CLINIC (2023–2024)

#### Overview

The **Help24 TeleHealth – Online Clinic** was launched as an innovative telemedicine platform to ensure uninterrupted access to high-quality healthcare services for key populations (KPs) and people living with HIV (PLHIV) in Ukraine. The ongoing war, mass displacement, and healthcare infrastructure disruptions created significant barriers to accessing medical care, necessitating an urgent expansion of digital health solutions.

In 2023–2024, Alliance for Public Health and Alliance Consultancy re-launched the existing Help24 Portal into the fully developed Help24 TeleHealth platform, introducing a comprehensive online clinic – Help24 TeleHealth (h24.org.ua) as one of the directions-services. The platform was designed to deliver digital healthcare services remotely, ensuring that displaced individuals, refugees, and those facing geographical and financial barriers could receive timely medical care.

The **Help24 Online Clinic** evolved into a full-service telemedicine ecosystem, integrating video consultations, mental health screenings, laboratory diagnostics, and medication delivery services. The project strengthened hybrid healthcare models, allowing for both digital and in-person consultations in key locations.



## Key **Objectives:**



Expand Help24 TeleHealth into a fully operational online clinic, providing virtual consultations, medical prescriptions, and follow-up care for PLHIV and KPs.



Ensure continuity of HIV care, ART prescriptions, PrEP access, mental health support, and STI treatment through telemedicine.



Strengthen telemedicine integration with Ukraine's national healthcare system, enhancing long-term digital healthcare accessibility.



Establish **three regional telemedicine hubs to support hybrid healthcare service models** and improve **digital health infrastructure.** 



Reach 5,000 clients, providing critical healthcare interventions through online and in-person services.



## Implementation & Achievements:

#### **Development and Expansion of the Online Clinic:**

- ✓ A fully functional telemedicine platform and mobile app was established, offering video consultations, virtual medical support, and digital healthcare solutions.
- Integrated mental health screenings (PHQ-2, PHQ-9), laboratory test referrals, medication delivery, and remote treatment plans.

#### **Service Delivery and Outreach:**

- √ 5,001 unique client-services provided, including:
  - 949 unique laboratory test referrals.
  - 1,405 unique verified patients registered in the Online Clinic.
  - 2,647 unique individuals received ART medication deliveries.
- Expanded into three telemedicine hubs in Kyiv, Dnipro, and Khmelnytskyi, fully equipped with state-of-the-art IT infrastructure and staffed by certified medical professionals.
- ✓ Supported the renovation and establishment of physical telemedicine cabinets within healthcare facilities.

#### **Capacity-Building and Training:**

- ✓ Provided technical training, certification workshops, and practical skill-building programs for doctors, healthcare professionals, and social workers.
- Conducted regular peer-to-peer knowledge exchange sessions, ensuring that healthcare providers were equipped to manage digital healthcare solutions effectively.



### **Mental Health and Psychological Support:**

- Conducted over 1,300 mental health screenings, referring individuals for virtual consultations with licensed mental health professionals.
- ✓ Integrated psychological support mechanisms into the telehealth platform, ensuring holistic care for PLHIV and key populations.

#### **Advancements in Digital Healthcare & Laboratory Diagnostics:**

- Successfully piloted a fully remote HIV PrEP prescription and follow-up model, allowing clients to access PrEP without physical visits, a crucial intervention for war-affected regions.
- ✓ Partnered with the Public Health Center of Ukraine, NGOs, and logistics providers to optimize medication distribution, digital healthcare coordination, and medical referrals.
- ✓ Developed **secure data encryption protocols**, ensuring **confidentiality and privacy protection** for online consultations and digital health records.
- ✓ Introduced specialized laboratory test referral packages, ensuring accessibility to essential health diagnostics, including:
  - Comprehensive STI and HIV monitoring tests.
  - Specialized trans-specific laboratory test packs, with 11 unique lab test referrals for transgender persons.



## Impact & Strategic Significance:

The **Help24 TeleHealth Online Clinic** represents a major step forward in Ukraine's digital healthcare evolution, providing accessible, inclusive, and stigma-free medical services for key populations and PLHIV from Ukraine. The project has:

- Redefined healthcare accessibility, ensuring that individuals in war affected zones, displaced, remote areas, and rural areas can still receive life-saving medical support.
- Prepared the integration of digital health solutions into Ukraine's national healthcare system (not possible fully due to war), contributing to the institutionalization of telemedicine as a long-term healthcare model.
- Bridged the gap between digital and in-person healthcare, offering hybrid solutions that enhance patient-centered care and healthcare resilience.

Following these achievements, a new project was launched in 2025 to sustain and expand the Online Clinic and Clinic Hub, ensuring continued innovation and long-term impact in digital healthcare solutions.





## **4. CLM – COMMUNITY-LED MONITORING** (2021–2024)

## Overview

Community-Led Monitoring (CLM) is an evidence-based approach that empowers communities to assess the accessibility, quality, and effectiveness of healthcare services. This project, led by APCASO and implemented by ATAC, strengthened civil society engagement in health system accountability, data-driven advocacy, and service monitoring in multiple countries.

Through capacity-building, technical assistance, and the development of standardized tools, the initiative equipped community organizations, key population networks, and civil society groups with the knowledge and resources needed to track health services, document challenges, and advocate for policy improvements.



## Implementation & Achievements:



#### **Development of CLM Tools & Resources:**

ATAC played a critical role in **designing and publishing standardized CLM methodologies**, ensuring that **CSOs and communities could monitor health service effectiveness.** Key training modules and guides developed included:

- Fundamentals of CLM Training Module (ENG, SP, FR)
- Partner Engagement, Communication, and Advocacy Guide (ENG, SP, FR, RU)
- Human Rights and HIV Training Module (ENG, SP, FR, RU)
- CLM of Human Rights Training Module (ENG, SP, FR, RU)
- Gender Training Module (ENG, SP, FR, RU)
- Community-Led Monitoring of HIV and Harm Reduction Services for People Who Use Drugs
- A Guide to CLM Data Collection Methods

These resources provided **comprehensive guidance on monitoring methodologies, human rights advocacy, and data-driven health system improvements.** 



#### **Technical Assistance (TA) & Country-Level Support:**

ATAC provided direct technical assistance to national partners, enhancing their ability to implement community-led monitoring approaches. Key interventions included:

- TA support to the Philippines and Bangladesh, strengthening community-based monitoring structures.
- **Technical assistance for Moldova,** equipping civil society groups with data collection and policy advocacy tools.
- Development of a centralized CLM digital resource hub, ensuring easy access to monitoring toolkits and best practices.

#### Overview

Between 2022 and 2024, Alliance Consultancy provided strategic technical assistance (TA) and capacity-building support to strengthen the role of civil society organizations (CSOs), improve healthcare program design, and enhance the effectiveness of national HIV and TB responses. Through tailored interventions in Serbia, Ukraine, and Kyrgyzstan, these projects supported CSOs, key population networks, and healthcare institutions to become more effective in program implementation, advocacy, and engagement with international funding mechanisms.

While each initiative was adapted to local contexts and needs, the core objective remained consistent—ensuring that civil society voices were meaningfully included in health policy development, funding decisions, and service delivery.



## Project: Technical Assistance for Serbia







#### **Implementation Period:**

Q4 2022 - Q1 2023

#### **Objective:**

Strengthen civil society's capacity to engage in HIV and TB prevention programs and Global Fund-related processes.

#### **Key Achievements:**

- Conducted a comprehensive assessment of 12 CSOs working in HIV and TB prevention, with a detailed capacity rating for nine organizations.
- Identified **gaps and opportunities** in programmatic, administrative, and financial management capacities.
- Developed **recommendations** for **CSO participation** in national HIV and TB responses, focusing on sustainability and funding strategies.
- Provided **capacity-building sessions** on advocacy, project management, and engagement with the Global Fund's funding model.
- Outlined a **national strategy** for improving CSO involvement in HIV prevention efforts, particularly for key populations (KPs).

#### Impact:

The project played a crucial role in **enhancing the visibility and participation of CSOs** in Serbia's national HIV/TB response. By strengthening advocacy efforts and technical capacities, it positioned **civil society as a key partner** in future public health strategies and funding negotiations.

#### **Objective:**

Support People Who Use Drugs (PWUD) networks in Ukraine to participate in Global Fund GC7 planning processes and national HIV/TB program development.

#### **Key Achievements:**

- Facilitated consultations with regional representatives from 13 oblasts, ensuring PWUD community priorities were reflected in Ukraine's Global Fund grant request (GC7).
- Organized and supported PWUD representation in national expert working groups and decision-making processes.
- Conducted capacity-building for PWUD community leaders on advocacy, leadership, and program coordination.
- Provided technical guidance for situational analysis and recommendations on rights-based interventions, including decriminalization efforts and harm reduction improvements.
- Strengthened collaboration between PWUD organizations and Global Fund mechanisms, enhancing the credibility and effectiveness of community-led monitoring (CLM).

#### Impact:

This project **ensured that the needs and priorities of PWUD communities were directly reflected in national HIV funding proposals,** empowering community networks to play an **active role in shaping Ukraine's response** to HIV and TB.



#### **Key Achievements:**

- Conducted a comprehensive evaluation of HIV prevention services, focusing on service coverage, outreach strategies, and detection rates.
- Recommended a **shift from broad coverage to targeted outreach**, prioritizing **high-risk groups** rather than traditional KP classifications.
- Introduced peer-driven interventions and digital outreach strategies, particularly for engaging youth and people using new psychoactive substances (NPS).
- Suggested optimizing HIV testing strategies, including the introduction of index testing, social network approaches (SNA), and differentiated service models.
- Developed **policy recommendations** to improve **legal protection**, **program funding**, and long-term sustainability of harm reduction services.

#### Impact:

The assessment provided **critical data and strategic recommendations** that will help Kyrgyzstan **optimize HIV prevention efforts** and improve funding allocation, ensuring more effective **community-led and harm reduction-based approaches.** 





## Overall Impact of Technical Assistance (2022–2024)

- Strengthened the technical capacity of CSOs, key population networks, and community-led organizations in Serbia, Ukraine, and Kyrgyzstan.
- Developed policy and programmatic recommendations that improved national HIV and TB prevention frameworks.

## Overview

Alliance Consultancy has played a key role in evidence-based policy development by conducting indepth research, evaluations, and strategic consulting on drug use trends, harm reduction approaches, and healthcare system improvements. By leveraging scientific methodologies and programmatic assessments, our research initiatives have provided valuable insights for governments, international agencies, and civil society organizations to enhance service delivery, inform national policies, and strengthen program effectiveness.

Through these initiatives, we contributed to data-driven decision-making in public health by mapping emerging drug use trends, assessing the efficiency of harm reduction programs, and identifying gaps in healthcare access for key populations. ## Project: European Drug Report Survey 2024 (EMCDDA)

Alliance Consultancy coordinated Ukraine's participation in this initiative, ensuring that Ukraine-specific data was collected, analyzed, and contributed to regional and European-level policy discussions.

#### **Key Objectives:**



Assess drug use patterns, focusing on opioids, cannabinoids, and polysubstance use.



Evaluate the impact of new psychoactive substances (NPS) on at-risk populations.

## Project: **Programmatic Review of HIV Prevention Services for PWIDs and MSM** (KPMG Bulgaria EOOD)



#### Overview:

This research project assessed the efficiency, coverage, and sustainability of HIV prevention services for people who inject drugs (PWIDs) and men who have sex with men (MSM) in Belarus. Conducted in collaboration with KPMG Bulgaria EOOD, the study focused on programmatic effectiveness, service accessibility, and alignment with international best practices.

#### **Key Objectives:**



Evaluate the effectiveness of harm reduction and HIV testing programs for PWIDs and MSM.



Identify gaps in service delivery, funding sustainability, and access to healthcare.



Strengthen HIV prevention strategies and propose policy recommendations for program improvements.

#### Implementation & Achievements:

- Conducted a comprehensive programmatic review of HIV services available to key populations.
- Identified service gaps and challenges affecting PWIDs and MSM, including legal barriers, funding shortages, and stigma-related healthcare access restrictions.
- Provided recommendations for improving HIV prevention services, including:
  - Expanding harm reduction programs for PWIDs, particularly in underserved regions.
  - **Enhancing outreach efforts** to MSM communities to improve service accessibility.
  - Strengthening linkages between harm reduction services and HIV care.
  - **Developing financial sustainability models** for long-term HIV prevention efforts.
- Conducted **policy dialogues with key stakeholders**, presenting evidence-based solutions for improving national HIV prevention strategies.

The study's findings were used to inform decision-makers and civil society organizations, fostering stronger multi-sectoral collaboration in the region.

The Research & Consulting initiatives undertaken between 2022 and 2024 have significantly contributed to regional drug policy reform, harm reduction program efficiency, and HIV prevention advancements. The studies have:

- Informed national and European drug policy discussions, ensuring that Ukraine's drugrelated challenges are reflected in regional and global strategies.
- Provided critical evidence for the expansion of harm reduction programs and policy improvements in Belarus and Ukraine.
- Strengthened civil society engagement in drug policy discussions, fostering better collaboration between governments, donors, and healthcare providers.
- Developed strategic recommendations for improving access to HIV prevention services for PWIDs and MSM in Eastern Europe.





# **KEY ACHIEVEMENTS** AND CUMULATIVE IMPACT (2022–2024)

Most of the projects undertaken by **Alliance Consultancy** were implemented in partnership and close collaboration with the **Alliance for Public Health (APH)** — our key institutional partner and founder organsiation organization. #### **Crisis-Driven Disruptions:**

The ongoing war in Ukraine has severely impacted healthcare infrastructure, disrupted service delivery, and increased barriers to accessing medical care for displaced populations, key populations (KPs), and people living with HIV (PLHIV). Emergency responses require continuous adaptation to shifting geopolitical and security conditions.



#### Sustainability of Telemedicine & Digital Health:

While telemedicine has been a groundbreaking tool in healthcare delivery, **long-term sustainability remains a challenge**. Ensuring continued funding, regulatory support, and full integration of telehealth into national health systems is critical to maintaining digital health solutions beyond emergency response phases.



#### **Data Protection & Digital Literacy:**

The expansion of digital healthcare services raises concerns about **data security, patient confidentiality, and digital literacy** among vulnerable populations. Strengthening cybersecurity measures while enhancing digital health literacy among service users and providers remains an ongoing priority.



#### **Policy & Legal Barriers to Healthcare Access:**

In some regions, **legal and policy frameworks are not yet fully aligned with digital health innovations.** Advocacy efforts must continue to ensure telemedicine and harm reduction services are fully recognized and integrated into national healthcare policies.



#### **Regional Healthcare System Fragmentation:**

In some regions, **legal and policy frameworks are not yet fully aligned with digital health innovations.** Advocacy efforts must continue to ensure telemedicine and harm reduction services are fully recognized and integrated into national healthcare policies.
